(In-suite <u>smoke</u> <u>detectors</u> are the individual owner's responsibility). **It is a Provincial Fire code requirement that Embers be able to inspect the devices in <u>all units</u> for our complex to pass the inspection. Unless all insuite smoke detectors and sprinkler heads are tested, Varsity will not be able to retain their fire safety certification. As such, please ensure that you are home during this time or make other arrangements for access to your suite.**

<u>NOTE:</u> <u>Please disarm any home alarm systems on your day of inspection</u> to avoid false alarms.

Please ensure that someone is available to allow access for the technicians; the entire in-suite test process takes approximately 3 minutes to complete.

Many owners have already provided keys to their units; for those residents that have not provided keys or have rekeyed their locks, please put your unit key in an envelope marked with your unit number and put the envelope in the Condo Drop Box in the mailroom area or slide the envelope under the door of unit #332 on the evenings of Feb.10 or Feb.11 from 4:00pm – 9:00 pm.

As a matter of convenience, a board member will be available the day of the test and will use that key to allow access to your unit. Should you prefer that the key not be used at this time and other arrangements have been made for access, kindly advise the building manager.
